English:

We use a genre-based system, teaching spelling, grammar and punctuation in context. Each unit involves a wide variety of immersive activities and drama which develop the children's speaking and listening skills. Children are given the opportunity to apply their learning regularly in Big Write sessions.

In Reading, we teach children a range of reading skills such as prediction, clarification, inference and summarising and use the Oxford Reading Tree scheme as part of this. Year 1 and 2 children are also taught phonics, building on from their learning in Nursery and Reception.

Maths:

We use the mastery teaching approach which means that children are taught using selected images and models to support their learning. Lessons are structured using small steps that move them from concrete to abstract and allow them to use their maths knowledge in a number of ways.

Turkish:

This is taught in accordance with the TRNC National Curriculum with a focus on reading, grammar and punctuation as well as speaking.

Science:

Children take part in investigative scientific activities as well as theoretical lessons in class. One of the annual highlights for our young scientists is the annual science fair run by senior students as they get to mix with older students and to learn from experiments they design.

Social:

Incorporates History and Geography – children learn about different historical eras throughout the ages; human and physical geography and map work of different continents, countries and local environments. From Year 3 children also learn about the main religions of the world, giving them an insight into different cultures.

Computing:

Our state of the art ICT suite is where our children can explore the world of technology in a safe and secure environment.

Art, Design & Food Technology:

Art, craft and design embody some of the highest forms of human creativity. Our art and design education engages, inspires and challenges our children, equipping them with the knowledge and skills to experiment, invent and create their own works of art, craft and design.



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Music:

Our Music department engages and inspires pupils to develop a love of music and their talent as musicians, and so increase their self-confidence, creativity and sense of achievement.

Physical Education:

Our students participate in a broad range of sporting activities with the aim to provide children with a life long love of sport and often compete against other local schools in competitions.

PSHE:

PSHE (Physical, Social, Health Education), is a subject through which pupils develop the knowledge, skills and attributes they need to keep themselves healthy and safe, and prepare for life and work in an ever changing world.

French:

From Year 4 onwards children study French, where they learn and develop the four key skills of language acquisition: speaking, writing, reading and listening. The ability to communicate and make themselves understood is a priority, balanced with the importance of developing an understanding of grammatical structures.
